


GUEST INFORMATION AND LOCAL BITS AND BOBS

Finish time

Under the terms of our license, the music and alcohol service ends at 11.30pm. Guests must be offsite by midnight, so please order buses, mini buses and taxis for 11.45pm.

Children

We welcome children at Oxleaze Barn but the venue is child-friendly rather than childproof! Children can run around and play games in the courtyard garden but we must insist they are monitored at all times for safety reasons.

Please be aware Oxleaze Farm is a working farm and, although not within the confines of Oxleaze Barn, there is a pond on the farm. Oxleaze Barn cannot accept responsibility for any children.

Parking

There is plenty of hard parking. Guests may leave their cars overnight, but are required to collect them between 8am and 12noon the following morning.

Taxis

Taxis are available locally but must be pre-booked. Please see Local Suppliers on the website for more information.

NB: We recommend you re-confirm your taxi closer to the time to reiterate pick up times and ensure they know the full address of Oxleaze Barn. Mobile reception can be limited on some networks should there be a problem with the taxi.



Train

The local train stations are:

- Swindon 17 miles ?? 55mins from London Paddington
- Charlbury 17 miles ?? 1hour 20mins from London Paddington

All three are operated by Southwest Trains and are on the direct line from London Paddington.

Local accommodation

The Five Alls at Filkins is our pick of the bunch – it is only a mile down the road and offers a traditional country pub atmosphere, comfortable beds and some seriously scrumptious food! The Plough at Kelmscott is under the same management as The Five Alls and also has rooms available.

Burford is only 5 miles away and offers everything from Travelodge to boutique hotels. Burford is a quintessential Cotswold market town and ideal for guests wanting to make a weekend of it.

Local Bits and Bobs

We have some fantastic local attractions if you have travelled far and would like to spend a bit longer getting to know the area:

- Burford: the prettiest high street in the Cotswolds! An afternoon can easily be whiled away perusing the shops and taking in the history of this unique town. No visit to Burford would be complete without a trip to Burford Garden Company – so much more than a garden centre!
- Filkins Woollen Weavers: A bit of history into how the Cotswolds spun wool into gold and a shop full of woolley goodies from fashion to furniture and a unique traditional selection of toys and games. Well worth a visit.
- Cotswold Wildlife Park: Kenya in the Cotswolds! The Cotswold Wildlife Park is only a couple of miles down the road and has everything from rhino to rabbits.
- Beautiful walks in the Windrush Valley: follow the Windrush River as it meanders its way through some of the most stunning countryside that harks back to Olde England!
- Boating on The Thames at Lechlade: being only 20miles from the source of The Thames it is great opportunity to hire a picnic boat and take to the seas for a leisurely afternoon.
- Daylesford Farm Shop is a farm shop to beat all farm shops. Beautifully presented in a traditional barn, Daylesford stocks some of the most spoiling local produce and is a real treat.
